### Main Learning focus - RSE / time to talk

We will be focusing on transition to new schools or new classes and meeting our new teachers and classes.

### English

In English KS2 will be writing letters to our teachers. These will focus on the things we enjoy, questions we may have about next year and things we are looking forward to. Year 6 will be writing letters to welcome our new foundation children.

Children will also be looking at stories, poetry and even putting on plays.

### Mathematics

In maths we will be looking at real-life problems and continuing to develop our skills in shape, statistics, co-ordinates and applying our calculation skills.

### Science

This year we have had 2 whole school science days. Children will be moving around different workshops experiencing a range of science activities.

### Art

In art we will be moving around different teachers exploring a range of art inspired by artists from the 1960s when school first opened.

### Music

In music we will be learning songs to perform either individually or as a group.

Year 5 and 6 will be performing a brass concert and the i-rock children will be performing a concert!

### RE

We will be reflecting on the religions that we have covered so far and discussing what we have learnt.

### PE

In games, we will be continuing with our cricket sessions.



### Computing

We will be reviewing our learning and thinking about how to keep safe online over the summer.

### History and geography

KS2 will be developing their geographical skills through map work involving compass points, grid references and coordinates.

LKS2 will be comparing historical periods that they have studied this year.
