Main Learning focus - History

We will be learning about space travel and the significant impact Neil Armstrong has had on the history of space travel. We will be using timelines and sources to help explore this.



English

We be exploring the book 'The Way Back Home' by Oliver Jeffers. We will use this book to help us to write a diary about an astronaut or an alien!

We will then use the book 'One Giant Leap' to create some non-fiction writing about Neil Armstrong.



Mathematics

Year One pupils will be beginning multiplication and division before moving on to fractions and position and direction.

Year Two pupils will be learning about fractions and time, there will also be a big focus on problem solving in the run up to the 'special workbooks'



Science

In science we will be using light and reflection as a focus to develop our enquiry skills.



Art

In art we will be exploring painting techniques and looking at the work of Peter Thorpe to create an 'out of this world' picture.



Computing

We will be using the teach computing Year One unit to develop our labelling and data skills.

Music

In music we will be listening, responding to and performing songs related to space and the moon landings.

RE

Our enquiry question is Why was Jesus welcomed like a King or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday?



PE

For indoor PE we will be exploring the creative cog for dance.

We will also be exploring the creative cog for outdoor PE focusing on ball skills.
